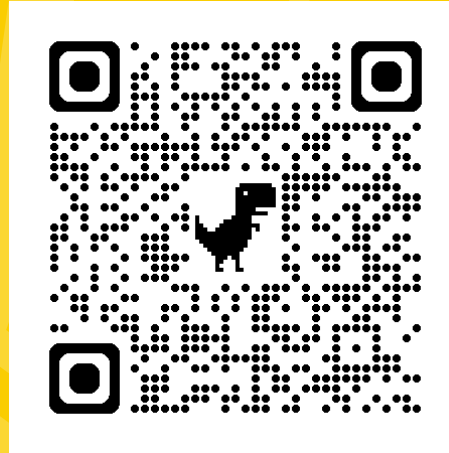

ABA (Applied Behavior Analysis) is science

ABA is based on the core principle that **behavior increases** when followed by **positive consequences** and decreases when followed by negative consequences.

- Based on "Behavioral Science," ABA is a scientific approach that studies how behavior changes through consequences and applies these findings to solve real-world problems.
- Using these scientific principles, ABA provides individualized interventions tailored to each child's characteristics.
- We systematically analyze behavior changes based on data to eliminate problem behaviors and reinforce desirable ones.
- We support generalization so that these behaviors can be maintained across various environments, including home, school, and the community.

Why Assessment is Important?

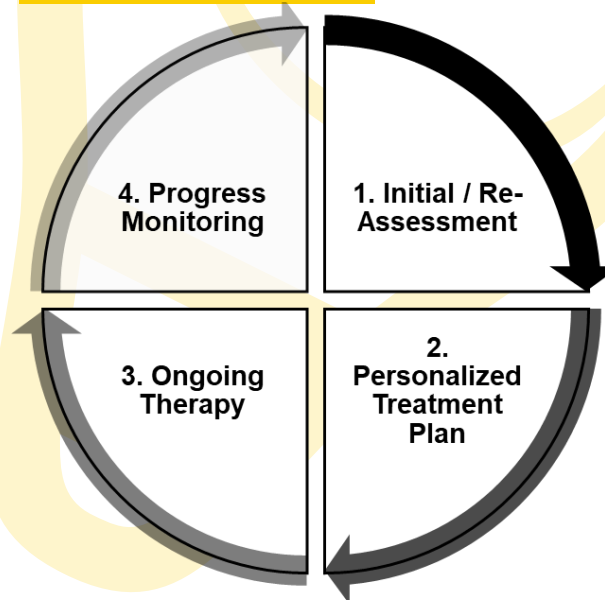
Assessment in ABA is more than simply evaluating a child. It is the **foundation for creating a personalized treatment plan**.

By identifying each child's **strengths and needs**, we determine which skills to build and which behaviors to reduce.

We then set **realistic and achievable goals** that support steady growth and meaningful progress. Assessment also helps us continuously monitor progress, ensuring that therapy remains effective and that strategies are adjusted when needed.

For this reason, **assessments should be conducted by experienced BCBA**, who use **data and scientific analysis** to select the **safest and most effective interventions** for each child.
